- But take diligent heed to do the commandment and the law, which Moses the servant

Keys

- Much land to take
- Expansion of Joseph
- Benefit of obedience and fortitude
- Taking the land that has been given
- Standard of operation and conduct
- Watching over the covenant

Slack, Slothful, Slow, Sluggard

Yet the children of Manasseh could not drive out the inhabitants of those cities; but the Canaanites would dwell in that land. - Joshua 17:12

- Manasseh's Inability to drive out the inhabitants of those cities
- Manasseh mingled amongst the other tribes
- Manasseh settled to place the inhabitants under tribute instead of driving them out
- Entertaining the compromises weakens the ultimate resolve of the entire people

Solved – A challenge to persevere

And the children of Joseph spake unto Joshua, saying, Why hast thou given me but one lot and one portion to inherit, seeing I am a great people, forasmuch as the LORD hath blessed me hitherto? – Joshua 17:14

- Feeling pressed in
- Boredom set in
- Your freedom hedge in
- Overwhelmed by limitations

QUIT COMPLAINING - DO SOMETHING!

Selection by lots

And Joshua said unto the children of Israel, How long are ye slack to go to possess the land, which the LORD God of your fathers hath given you? – Joshua 18:3

- The land was to be scouted out 3 selected from every tribe
- The land was divided into 7 parts
- Their inheritance was allotted by casting lots

Standards of operation verified

Then Joshua called the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh, And said unto them, Ye have kept all that Moses the servant of the LORD commanded you, and have obeyed my voice in all that I commanded you: – Joshua 22:3,3

Take good heed therefore unto yourselves, that ye love the LORD your God – Joshua 23:11

- Courage required to encompass the allotted land
- Circumspect, watchful and determined to keep the covenant
- Charge to the leaders
- Consecration and warning not to move away

Standards of operation verified – Cont'd

Therefore it shall come to pass, that as all good things are come upon you, which the LORD your God promised you; so shall the LORD bring upon you all evil things, until he have destroyed you from off this good land which the LORD your God hath given you. – Joshua 24:15
