Introduction

- And the asses of Kish Saul's father were lost. And Kish said to Saul his son, Take now one
 of the servants with thee, and arise, go seek the asses. 1 Samuel 9:3
- And when they were come to the land of Zuph, Saul said to his servant that was with him, Come, and let us return; lest my father leave caring for the asses, and take thought for us. – 1 Samuel 9:5
- And he said unto him, Behold now, there is in this city a man of God, and he is an honourable man; all that he saith cometh surely to pass: now let us go thither; peradventure he can shew us our way that we should go. 1 Samuel 9:6
- And as they went up the hill to the city, they found young maidens going out to draw water, and said unto them, Is the seer here? – 1 Samuel 9:11

Introduction – Cont'd

- As soon as ye be come into the city, ye shall straightway find him, before he go up to the high place to eat: for the people will not eat until he come, because he doth bless the sacrifice; and afterwards they eat that be bidden. Now therefore get you up; for about this time ye shall find him. – 1 Samuel 9:13
- Now the LORD had told Samuel in his ear a day before Saul came, saying. o morrow about this time I will send thee a man out of the land of Benjamin, and thou shalt anoint him to be captain over my people Israel, that he may save my people out of the hand of the Philistines: for I have looked upon my people, because their cry is come unto me. 1 Samuel 9:15,16

Introduction – Cont'd

- And when Samuel saw Saul, the LORD said unto him, Behold the man whom I spake to thee of! this same shall reign over my people. – 1 Samuel 9:17
- And Saul answered and said, Am not I a Benjamite, of the smallest of the tribes of Israel? and my family the least of all the families of the tribe of Benjamin? wherefore then speakest thou so to me? 1 Samuel 9:21
- Then Samuel took a vial of oil, and poured it upon his head, and kissed him, and said, is it not because the LORD hath anointed thee to be captain over his inheritance? – 1
 Samuel 10:1

Introduction – Cont'd

- And ye have this day rejected your God, who himself saved you out of all your adversities and your tribulations; and ye have said unto him, Nay, but set a king over us. Now therefore present yourselves before the LORD by your tribes, and by your thousands. – 1 Samuel 10:19
- And Saul also went home to Gibeah; and there went with him a band of men, whose hearts God had touched. – 1 Samuel 10:26
- But the children of Belial said, How shall this man save us? And they despised him, and brought him no presents. But he held his peace. 1 Samuel 10:27

The search for asses

And the asses of Kish Saul's father were lost. And Kish said to Saul his son, Take now one of the servants with thee, and arise, go seek the asses. – 1 Samuel 9:3

Asses assumed astray

- The search through 5 lands that eventually takes them to the seer
- An exhaustive search
- Their search brings them to where they can hear the Lord
- Highlighting the need to consult with the Lord through the man of God

The search for Samuel

And he said unto him, Behold now, there is in this city a man of God, and he is an honourable man; all that he saith cometh surely to pass: now let us go thither; peradventure he can shew us our way that we should go. – 1 Samuel 9:6

Last resort – A purposeful search for the seer

- Young maidens at the entrance of the city 1 Samuel 9:11
- The right resource to the source "..make haste" 1 Samuel 9:12
- The right information for the location of the source 1 Samuel 9:12
- The right timing for finding the source "...for about this time ye shall find him" 1 Samuel 9:13
- They intercept Samuel as he was going up to the high place 1 Samuel 9:14

The search for meaning

Now the LORD had told Samuel in his ear a day before Saul came, saying. o morrow about this time I will send thee a man out of the land of Benjamin, and thou shalt anoint him to be captain over my people Israel, that he may save my people out of the hand of the Philistines: for I have looked upon my people, because their cry is come unto me. – 1 Samuel 9:15,16

- Tomorrow about this time I will send thee a man... 1 Samuel 9:16
- Behold the man whom I spoke to thee of! 1 Samuel 9:17
- Divine connection 1 Samuel 9:19
- Divine resolutions 1 Samuel 9:20

The search for meaning – Cont'd

The search for Saul

The assembly at the watchtower – Mizpeh

- The solemn protest of the Lord against Israel's choice 1 Samuel 10:18-19
- The selection by Tribe and family
- The search for Saul inquiry upon the Lord yields a timely response
- Israel is presented her king!
- Kingmakers touched by the Lord join Saul
- Sons of Belial repel him There are always those in every community!
