Introduction

Key Scriptures

- And they sent messengers to the inhabitants of Kirjathjearim, saying, The Philistines have brought again the ark of the LORD; come ye down, *and* fetch it up to you. – 1 Samuel 6:21
- And the men of Kirjathjearim came, and fetched up the ark of the LORD, and brought it into the house of Abinadab in the hill, and sanctified Eleazar his son to keep the ark of the LORD. – 1 Samuel 7:1
- And it came to pass, while the ark abode in Kirjathjearim, that the time was long; for it was twenty years: and all the house of Israel lamented after the LORD. – 1 Samuel 7:2



Introduction

Key Scriptures

- Again, David gathered together all *the* chosen *men* of Israel, thirty thousand. – 2 Samuel 6:1
- And David arose, and went with all the people that *were* with him from Baale of Judah, to bring up from thence the ark of God, whose name is called by the name of the LORD of hosts that dwelleth *between* the cherubims. – 2 Samuel 6:2
- And when they came to Nachon's threshingfloor, Uzzah put forth *his hand* to the ark of God, and took hold of it; for the oxen shook *it*. And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Uzzah; and God smote him there for *his* error; and there he died by the ark of God. – 2 Samuel 6:6,7



Introduction – Cont'd

Key Scriptures

- And David was afraid of the LORD that day, and said, How shall the ark of the LORD come to me? So David would not remove the ark of the LORD unto him into the city of David: but David carried it aside into the house of Obededom the Gittite. – 2 Samuel 6:9,10
- And it was told king David, saying, The LORD hath blessed the house of Obededom, and all that *pertaineth* unto him, because of the ark of God. So David went and brought up the ark of God from the house of Obededom into the city of David with gladness. – 2 Samuel 6:12
- And it was so, that when they that bare the ark of the LORD had gone six paces, he sacrificed oxen and fatlings. – 2 Samuel 6:13



Introduction – Cont'd

Key Scriptures

- At that time the LORD separated the tribe of Levi, to bear the ark of the covenant of the LORD, to stand before the LORD to minister unto him, and to bless in his name, unto this day. – Deuteronomy 10:8
- And as the ark of the LORD came into the city of David, Michal Saul's daughter looked through a window, and saw king David leaping and dancing before the LORD; and she despised him in her heart. – 2 Samuel 6:16
- Therefore Michal the daughter of Saul had no child unto the day of her death. – 2 Samuel 6:23

Instructions

Insolence

And as the ark of the LORD came into the city of David, Michal Saul's daughter looked through a window, and saw king David leaping and dancing before the LORD; and she despised him in her heart. – 2 Samuel 6:16

Praise, adoration and worship and its effect (action)

- An Impudent face and a heart set on strife (None but her knew of her disdain)
- Contempt for the success of others



Insolence – Cont'd

Amid intreating the Lord for the Land and his household

- Amid worship and adoration
- Amid blessing and making provision for blessings
- Floodgates of gates of brass!
