And thine house and thy kingdom shall be established for ever before thee: thy throne shall be established for ever. – 2 Samuel 7:16

Things about the LORD

Then went king David in, and sat before the LORD, and he said, Who am I, O Lord GOD? and what is my house, that thou hast brought me hitherto? – 2 Samuel 7:18

David rehearses all these things before the LORD

- Remembers his estate
- Remembers who the LORD is
- Reverence and worship before the LORD
- Raises the assembly of Israel before the LORD

Things to remember

And now, O LORD God, the word that thou hast spoken concerning thy servant, and concerning his house, establish it for ever, and do as thou hast said. . – 2 Samuel 7:25

- The words concerning Israel

- The unique rehearsal of all the LORD's promises
