Key Scriptures

- 2. Your Assignment on the earth is to solve a problem for somebody, somewhere and receive a reward for it.
- 3. When you Assignment is unrecognized, you are uncelebrated. When you are not celebrated, you are not rewarded.
- 4. No torment of earth equals the torment of living a life unrewarded for the gift and solution lying dormant within you.

The Law of Recognition – 10 Facts You Must Know About Your Assignment

Fact #1.

- 1. Your Assignment Is Always To A Person or A People.
- But the LORD said unto me, Say not, I am a child: for thou shalt go to all that I shall send thee, and whatsoever I command thee thou shalt speak. – Jeremiah 1:7
- ii. Whereunto I am appointed a preacher, and an apostle, and a teacher of the Gentiles. 2 Timothy 1:11

Fact #2.

- 2. Your Assignment Determines The Suffering And Attacks You Encounter.
- Whereunto I am appointed a preacher, and an apostle, and a teacher of the Gentiles. – 2 Timothy 1:11
- ii. For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day. 2 Timothy 1:12

Fact #3.

- What Grieves You Is A Clue To What You Are Assigned To Heal And Restore
- i. Remember Nehemiah...He understood this -And said unto the king, Let the king live for ever: why should not my countenance be sad, when the city, the place of my fathers' sepulchres, lieth waste, and the gates thereof are consumed with fire? - Nehemiah 2:3
- ii. Compassion is always a signpost to the geographical location where you belong. What makes you cry is a clue to the problem God has qualified you to heal.

Fact #4.

- 4. What You Love The Most Reveals The Greatest Gifts You Contain
- Passion is the path to your wisdom
- ii. When I know what love to talk about, think about and learn about – that is your place of Assignment.
- iii. You will only have wisdom for something you love
- iv. What do you love the most?

Fact #4. — Cont'd

- 4. What You Love The Most Reveals The Greatest Gifts You Contain
- i. The Proof of Love Is The Investment of Time –
 Mike Murdock
- ii. When I find where you are willing to invest your time, I know what you love. That is your Assignment.
- iii. This is why Moses was willing to counsel with people from daylight to dark-he loved his people with all his heart Exodus 18:13-14

Fact #5.

- Your Assignment is Geographical
- i. Where you are matters as much as what you are.
- ii. You may be a beautiful whale but you better be in water!
- iii. Geography matters! It controls the flow of favor in your life Acts 8:26-40
- iv. Who sees you determines who Promotes you.
- v. You will rarely receive favor unless someone sees you.
- vi. Geography affects the increase of favor. 1 Kings 17

Fact #6.

- 6. You Will Only Succeed When Your Assignment Becomes An Obsession
- i. That explains the Apostle Paul's uncommon achievement. Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.
 - Philippians 3:13,14

Fact #7.

- 7. You Assignment Will Require Seasons of Preparation
- i. "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of truth," 2 Timothy 2:15.
- You will experience seasons of insignificance, isolation, waiting, warfare, persecution, injustice, silence and promotion.
- iii. Jesus invested 30 years of preparation for three-and-one-half years of ministry. – See Luke 3:23



Fact #8.

- 8. You Assignment May Be Misunderstood By Your Own Family And Those Closest To You.
- jesus experienced this: "For neither did his brethren believe in Him," – John 7:5.
- ii. Stay aware of your difference from others.
- iii. God provides your family to prepare you for an enemy.
- iv. Everything in your future is already in your present house, Judas or Doubting Thomas!



Fact #9.

- 9. Your Assignment Will Always Have An Enemy
- i. The servant is not above his lord.
- ii. Jesus declared it "If the world hate you, ye know that it hated Me before it hated you...The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted Me, they will also persecute you,"
 - John 15:18, 20-21
- iii. Your enemies are as necessary as your friends.

Fact #10.

- 10. You Assignment Is The Only Place Your Financial Provision Is Guaranteed
- i. God instructed Elijah to go to the brook where a raven would feed him. – 1 King 17
- ii. There, he received his daily provision
- iii. One day, the brook dried up. Why? His Assignment changed
- iv. Lack is a clue God is changing your assignment.
- v. Elijah's new Assignment was to visit Zarephath where a starving widow would receive her financial miracle throughout the remaining part of the famine.
- vi. When God sends you to a place, provision is the promised incentive for obedience.
