Healing The Sick – Scripture References

1. *Heb 10:7 Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of me,) to do thy will, O God.*
2. *Joh 6:38 For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.*
3. *Mar 1:40 And there came a leper to him, beseeching him, and kneeling down to him, and saying unto him, If thou wilt, thou canst make me clean.*
4. *2Pe 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.*
5. *Jas 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:*
6. *Num 21:9 And Moses made a serpent of brass, and put it upon a pole, and it came to pass, that if a serpent had bitten any man, when he beheld the serpent of brass, he lived.*

7. *Heb 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.*
8. *Mat 12:15 But when Jesus knew it, he withdrew himself from thence: and great multitudes followed him, and he healed them all;*
9. *Mat 14:36 And besought him that they might only touch the hem of his garment: and as many as touched were made perfectly whole.*
10. *Luk 6:19 And the whole multitude sought to touch him: for there went virtue out of him, and healed them all.*
11. *Mat 8:16,17 When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick: That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.*

12. *Psa 89:34 My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips.*
13. *Luk 4:40 Now when the sun was setting, all they that had any sick with divers diseases brought them unto him; and he laid his hands on every one of them, and healed them.*
14. *Act 8:6 And the people with one accord gave heed unto those things which Philip spake, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did.*
15. *Act 8:7 For unclean spirits, crying with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed with them: and many taken with palsies, and that were lame, were healed.*
16. *Act 8:8 And there was great joy in that city.*

17. *Act 14:8 And there sat a certain man at Lystra, impotent in his feet, being a cripple from his mother's womb, who never had walked:*
18. *Act 14:9 The same heard Paul speak: who stedfastly beholding him, and perceiving that he had faith to be healed,*
19. *Act 14:10 Said with a loud voice, Stand upright on thy feet. And he leaped and walked.*

Introduction

Healing for All – Introduction

1. Is it still the will of God, as it was in the past, to heal *all* who have need of healing?
2. It is impossible to boldly claim by faith a promise or blessing that you are uncertain God is offering, because the promises or blessings of God can be claimed *only* where the *will* of God is *known*, trusted and acted upon.

1. What is the meaning of the word **Testament**?
2. If healing is in God's **will** for us, then to say God is not willing to heal **all**, as His Will states so clearly, would be to change the Will, and that, after the death of the **Testator**.
3. Jesus – The Testator that died
4. The best way to ascertain what the **will of God** is.
5. **Jesus was the expression of the Father's Will**

If It Be Thy Will?

1. Doing the *will of God* for *all* people.
2. The message everywhere taught in the Gospels is one of **COMPLETE HEALING** for soul and body, for **ALL** who will come to Him. – F. F. Bosworth
3. Many today say, *‘I believe in healing, but I do not believe it is for everyone.’* If it is not for everyone, then how could we ever pray the **PRAYER OF FAITH?**” – F. F. Bosworth
4. The cry of an outcast leper – *“If it be thy will”*
5. The first thing Christ did was to correct this uncertainty by **assuring** him, **I will.**
6. It is no longer, *if it be Thy will* – **it is God’s will.**
7. **God will heal the sick.** *If He wills to heal one, He wills to heal all.*

If It Be Thy Will? – Cont'd

If It Be Thy Will? – Cont'd

8. As many (whosoever) as look to Christ as Redeemer are saved
9. All are on equal basis when It comes to the benefits of the Atonement
10. The words, **whosoever** and **whosoever will**, are always used to invite sinners to be saved.
11. The words, **as many, everyone, all, any** are always used to invite the sick and diseased to be healed.
12. Both invitations are always universal, and the results are always *positively* promised: **shall be saved; shall have life; shall recover; shall raise him up; healed them all; and as many as touched him were healed**

If It Be Thy Will? – Cont'd

13. The benefits of Calvary are for you
14. Christ is still healing *the sick* in order to fulfill the prophet's words: *Himself took **our** infirmities (weaknesses) and bare **our** sicknesses (diseases).*
15. Always remember: You are included in the "our" of Matthew 8:17.
16. God is bound by His covenant to continue to heal *all* who are sick and weak, in order to fulfill Isaiah's words
17. **Healing was for all** in those days, and **Christ the healer** has never changed

Healing Is for All

Healing The Sick – Healing for All

Should be Preached to All

1. Philip preached Christ and Jesus proved to be exactly the same when Philip preached Him.
2. Peter preached Christ, and the cripple was healed. Jesus proved to be exactly the same for Peter.
3. Wherever and whenever, Jesus Christ is preached in His full sacrifice for sin and sicknesses, healing will result for sick bodies, as well as salvation for lost souls.
4. Paul preached Christ. Jesus proved to be exactly the same for Paul.
5. Wherever healing is preached in its full benefits for *all*, and people give heed to the Word preached, faith is *always* imparted, and the people are *always* healed.
6. Let it be forever settled and established: **It is God's will to heal me.**

When Jesus “laid His hands on **EVERY ONE** of them and healed them,” He was revealing and doing the *will* of God for **all** people. - T. L. Osborn
